

MORITZ GNANN CONDUCTOR

Moritz Gnann is regularly invited to the Semperoper Dresden and to the Deutsche Oper Berlin. In his native country, Germany, he has also conducted the Leipzig Gewandhaus, the MDR Symphony Orchestra and the Badische Staatskapelle Karlsruhe. Elsewhere, Moritz has worked with the BBC Philharmonic, the BBC National Orchestra of Wales, the Ulster Orchestra, the Scottish Chamber Orchestra, the Orchestre Philharmonique du Luxembourg and the Australian Youth Orchestra.

Moritz Gnann studied conducting in Berlin and Dresden. He started his professional career at Theater Aachen before taking up a tenure at the Teatro Nacional de Saõ Carlos in Lisbon. Moritz then moved on to the Deutsche Oper Berlin and the Boston Symphony Orchestra, where he finished a successful tenure as Assistant Conductor. He was a regular member of the Bayreuther Festspiele from 2010 to 2016, where he worked together with Andris Nelsons on Lohengrin and Parsifal.
